

II. Specificity of character-narrator: the embedded narrative by Stefan Zweig

[Stefan Zweig : Austrian author (1881-1942)]

First narrator (character-narrator) → second character → second narrative (auto-narrative)

Neutral place

One narrative (the first), no possibility to comment

Unknown characters

III. Embedded narrative, crisis, and self-knowing

Reader → watcher
Hermeneutic circle through
auto-narrative
Transparency → empathy

IV. The axiological problem

Axiological reference = narrator
Change of narrator, end of narrative

→ no possibility to judge
=> empathy and esthetics of freedom
