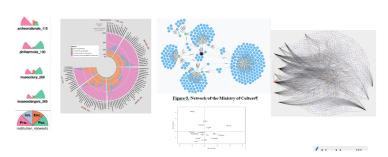

The profound ongoing changes in the museum context

- Questions raised by the engagement of cultural institutions in digital media and tools
 - A transversal process of "modernization", increased attention to the lay public (Freeman et al., 2016; Gottesdiener et Davallon, 2013; Poulot, 2014), new museology (Mairesse, 2000), changes in processes and devices (*Culture et musées* journal)
 - Cultural marketing (Greffret et al., 2017) and market dimension
- The "eventualization" of culture: the "shift of the heritage institution into the logic of flow media" (Jacobi, 2013)

Two transversal axes of analysis of a cultural event

- The organizational and media framework of the cultural event
 - Organizational framework of the cultural event
 - Media framework (digital media) and editorial devices.
 - Identifying stakeholders, analysing their modes of participation, interaction patterns and relationships.
- The articulation between the info-communication logics of the stakeholders and the modes of circulation of message flows
 - Analyzing content of messages and forms of cultural mediation.
 - Analyzing the circulation modes of message flows

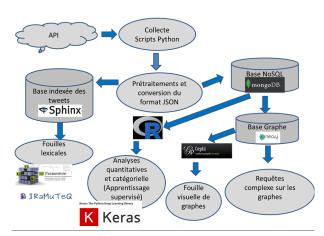

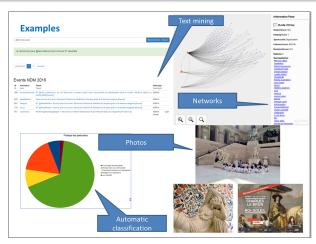

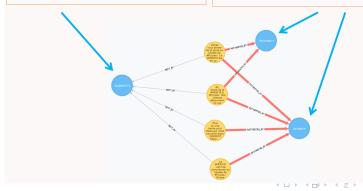

Relayed Account: An account whose tweets are relayed or mentioned

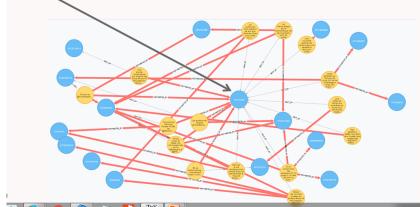
Relaying account: An account which retweets or mentions tweets of other accounts

Scoring accounts with six attributes

Attribute	Method
Participant	0 (no participation in the considered period of time) or 1
Producer	Total amount of tweets and retweets
Relayed	Total number of accounts which relayed his/her original tweets
Relaying	Total number of accounts she/he relayed
Mentioned	Total number of mention of the account in text tweets
Passing	Product of relayed score by relaying score

- A methodology to analyze forms of engagement, participation and relationships between cultural institutions, organizations and audiences
- A model based on six attributes to qualify accounts according to their modes of participation
- Only one private account played a major role in disseminating information
- Cultural events have a political and socio-economic dimension
- A software processing workflow

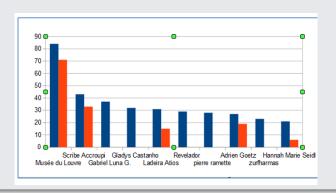

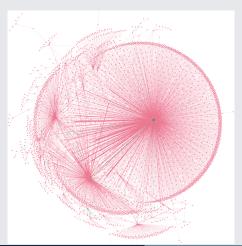

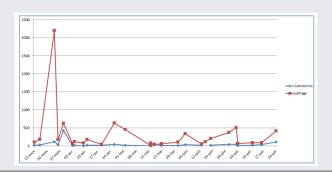
