



# Old Assyrian Bibliography 4

July 2015 - December 2019

This fourth addition to the Old Assyrian Bibliography follows the structure of OAAS 1 [C. Michel, *Old Assyrian Bibliography of Cuneiform Texts, Bullae, Seals and the Results of the Excavations at Aššur, Kültepe/Kaniš, Acemhöyük, Alişar and Boğazköy*, Leiden, 2003], OAB 1 [C. Michel, *Old Assyrian Bibliography 1* (February 2003 - July 2006), *AfO* 51 (2005-2006), p. 436-449], OAB 2 [C. Michel, *Old Assyrian Bibliography 2* (August 2006 - April 2009), *AfO* 52 (2011), p. 416-437] and OAB 3 [C. Michel, *Old Assyrian Bibliography* (May 2009 - March 2015), *AfO* 53 (2015), p. 525-559]. It contains corrections and additions to OAAS 1, OAB 1, OAB 2 and OAB 3: books and articles published between April 2015 and December 2019, titles published before and forgotten in the previous issues, reviews, new tablets discovered during the excavations or housed in private collections, line quotations of tablets preserved in the Museum of Anatolian Civilizations in Ankara and Kayseri, etc. Furthermore, due to a technical error in the typesetting of the manuscript, KIM 3 which was supposed to be dated to 2019 is finally dated to 2020. Nevertheless, it has been included in this bibliography. My thanks go to the editors of *Archiv für Orientforschung* who give me the opportunity to publish regular updates of the *Old Assyrian Bibliography* and I also wish to express my gratitude to all the colleagues who offered me help for this supplement by providing me with lists of their publications and offprints, especially İ. Albayrak, G. Barjamovic, M. Çayır, J. G. Dercksen, H. Erol, N. J. C. Kouwenberg, F. Kulakoğlu, R. Kuzuoğlu, A. W. Lassen and K. R.
