






Plan de la ville de Sofia / Map of the city of Sofia, 1887


Notary inventories 18th-1st ½ 19th century : • more than half of the inventories mention copper or metal containers,

the average number by inventory is 3 when the number is stated
generally, ceramic containers are mentioned only as product containers







- 18th : 15 of 63 inventories, special mention metal (?) « **dishes** » in addition to **copper or metal containers**,
- 19th : no more metal (?) « **dishes** » but a lot of cooper containers
