









(reconstruction)*


2. EXPERTISE IN MOTION (1973-1977) (4)

“[...] eco-development is a development style [including the satisfaction of basic needs, the management of natural resources and intergenerational equity] which, in each eco-region, puts the emphasis on the specific solutions to particular problems, taking into account ecological but also cultural realities, for the short and long terms. [...] The concept of eco-development seeks to be operative. It is an action guidance (or, if one prefers, a philosophy of development) whose relevance can only be judged in the light of practice.” (Sachs, 1974, pp. 560, 569)

3. Time for standardization (1978-1986)


3. TIME FOR STANDARDIZATION (1978-1986) (1)

- Institutional changes
 - Integration of « hors statut »
 - Affiliation to CNRS
- Disciplinary changes
 - Specialization, methods
 - The group of “econometricians” vs. Ignacy Sachs



3. TIME FOR STANDARDIZATION (1978-1986) (2)

- The 1985-1986 crisis
 - Sachs' succession?
 - Scientific identity?
 - Institutional & disciplinary position?
